PARENTS EDUCATING PARENTS (PEP) RALLY GUIDELINES

The goal of the parents educating parents rally is to get parents (PTSA members) discussing the topic of safe driving with their teenagers. This covers everything from teaching them how to drive to making sure they are aware of Georgia teen driving laws and everything in between.

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PARENTS EDUCATING PARENTS (PEP) CONTEST RULES

Winning PTSA will receive a cash prize.

1. The minimum number of parent/guardian attendees is 50 per rally. A PTSA may hold multiple rallies during the 6 months of the contest, but only the one with the most attendees will be considered for the prize.
2. Documentation is required of all attendees, name, address, phone #, email address, age & grade of their teen. The date, time and location of the meeting should be recorded as well.
3. Topic of the rally must be related to safe teen driving.
4. Print out and complete the RALLY CONTEST ENTRY FORM on this website and submit (along with the list of attendees and their information) to Safe America after the rally is held. You can also use your own sign up sheet, as long as you have the required information.
5. Rallies must be held by April 10, 2012 and paperwork must be submitted by April 25, 2012.
6. The PTA that wins the contest will be notified by Safe America, and the winning school's name will be posted on www.safeamericadrivers.org.
